

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

\$5000 PRIZE FOR THE BEST NEWS STORY OR FEATURE ON ANAESTHESIA OR PAIN MEDICINE

The Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (ANZCA) and the Faculty of Pain Medicine (FPM) will award \$5000 for the best news story or feature on anaesthesia or pain medicine to appear in Australia or New Zealand in print, on television, on radio or online between January 1, 2012 – December 31, 2012.

All entries will be judged on their originality and the impact they may have had in explaining anaesthesia or pain medicine to the community.

Quality of writing will be taken into account for written pieces and quality of sound and footage for broadcast material.

Please observe the following information on how to enter:

- Entries must have been published or broadcast in an Australian or New Zealand media organisation.
- Entries must have been published or broadcast between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012.
- Entries must be received no later than 6pm Friday January 25, 2013.
- Entries must be accompanied by the correct entry form (found at www.anzca.edu.au/communications/Media.)
- Four copies of each entry must be supplied.
- A recent colour head shot, preferably electronic, and no smaller than passport size must be supplied.
- A statement of no more than 400 words explaining the appropriate background, research and other factors supporting the nomination must be supplied.
- The winner and his/her organisation will be notified in February 2013 and an announcement will be placed on the ANZCA website with a link to the winning entry and judges' comments. The winner will also be announced in the *ANZCA Bulletin*.
- ANZCA reserves the right to reproduce entries for the promotion of the awards.
- The judges' decision is final and entries will not be returned.
