A webinar for trainees preparing to sit the ANZCA Primary Exam

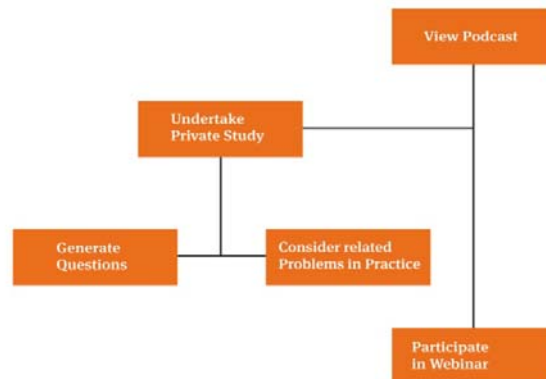
15 February 2012 (7.30 - 8.30pm AEDT)

The Education Development Unit has recently developed a number of e-Learning resources to assist trainees preparing for the ANZCA Primary Examination. As part of this initiative, trainees are invited to participate in an online webinar (also commonly referred to as a web conference) with Dr. David Sturgess from Queensland. During this hour long session, Dr. Sturgess will be available on-line to answer questions from participating trainees about *Measurement of CVS Function*, the two-part video podcast he recorded for ANZCA's e-Learning library. The webinar will also feature on the spot quizzes and short case based discussions to promote interaction between the presenter and the trainees participating.
