



## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### **\$A5000 PRIZE FOR THE BEST NEWS STORY OR FEATURE ON ANAESTHESIA OR PAIN MEDICINE**

The Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists and the Faculty of Pain Medicine will award \$A5000 for the best media report on anaesthesia or pain medicine to appear in Australia or New Zealand between January 1, 2018 – December 31, 2018.

The award is open to all media either as an individual or team entry. The award can recognise a single report, a podcast, a series of up to four reports or long form journalism.

All entries will be judged on their originality, quality of journalism and their ability to explain the research, management or practice of anaesthesia or pain medicine to the community. Also taken into consideration will be the ability to explain complex medical terms in a clear and community-friendly manner, as well as the accuracy and complexity of the entry and the research involved.

Please observe the following information on how to enter:

- Entries must have been published or broadcast by an Australian or New Zealand media organisation.
- Entries must have been published or broadcast between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018.
- Entries must be received no later than 6pm Tuesday January 29, 2019.
- TV or video entries must be posted to ANZCA Media Award 2018, 630 St Kilda Road Melbourne, Vic 3004. Four copies of each entry and entry form ([www.anzca.edu.au/communications/Media](http://www.anzca.edu.au/communications/Media)) must be supplied.
- All other entries can be emailed to [communications@anzca.edu.au](mailto:communications@anzca.edu.au) and must be accompanied by the entry form, a recent colour head shot of the entrant and PDF, JPG files or non-paywall URL links. Audio files can be submitted via file-sharing platforms in either AIFF or WAV format.
- A statement of no more than 400 words explaining the appropriate background, research and other factors supporting the nomination must be supplied.
- The winner and organisation will be notified in March 2019 and an announcement will be placed on the ANZCA website with a link to the winning entry and judges' comments. The winner will also be announced in the *ANZCA Bulletin*.
- ANZCA reserves the right to reproduce entries for the promotion of the awards.
- The judges' decision is final and entries will not be returned.
