The Mid North Coast Local Health District is seeking to employ a specialist anaesthetist at Port Macquarie Base Hospital. The successful applicant must be registered with AHPRA as a specialist and be a Fellow of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists. He or she will be joining a department of 17 specialist anaesthetists and will assist in providing specialist care in what is an expanding clinical services scope.

Port Macquarie is located on the Mid North Coast of NSW about four hours' drive north of Sydney and six hours drive south of Brisbane. The seaside town boasts many gorgeous beaches, a lush hinterland, a diverse variety of attractions including the Koala Hospital, Billabong Zoo, river cruises and one of the best year-round climates in Australia.

Port Macquarie Base Hospital is a 195-bed, role delineation level five, public teaching hospital, providing 24 hour Emergency Services, Critical Care, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, General Medicine, Gastroenterology, Respiratory Medicine, Cardiology, Renal Medicine, Oncology, Haematology, Gerontology and Rehab Services, Rheumatology, Infectious Diseases, Palliative Care, Drug and Alcohol Services, General Surgery, Upper and Lower GI Surgery, Hepatobiliary Surgery, Vascular Surgery, Orthopaedic Surgery, ENT, Ophthalmology, Urology, Faciomaxillary Surgery, Paediatrics and Mental Health services to the people of the surrounding areas with a population of approximately 120,000.

Support services include Radiology (CT, MRI, Ultrasound, XRay, DSA) on site with 24 hour access, pathology with 24 hour access including Chemistry, Haematology, basic Microbiology, basic Histopathology and blood bank.

Port Macquarie Base Hospital has established links with several universities including the University of New South Wales, Newcastle University and Charles Sturt University, and supports a variety of medical research. The successful applicant will have the opportunity to actively participate research and QA activities.
