Training requirements for trainees in the 2013 curriculum

Core Unit Checklists

Introductory Training	
Minimum of 26 weeks total training time recorded and confirmed, including:	
Minimum of 22 continuous weeks Clinical anaesthesia time (CAT)	
Maximum of 1 week of Other Clinical time (OCT) / 4 weeks of OCT with no leave	
Maximum of 3 weeks leave / 4 weeks of leave with no OCT	
Initial assessment of anaesthetic competence: questions & WBAs confirmed by SOT in TPS	
All IT WBAs	
All IT cases and procedures	
ALS course completed within 52 weeks prior to the completion of IT	
Core unit review	
A clinical placement review completed at the beginning and end of each placement and at least every 26 weeks.	

Basic Training Core Unit Checklist	
Minimum of 78 weeks total training time recorded and confirmed, including:	
Minimum of 69 weeks CAT (combined with IT)	
Maximum of 16 weeks leave (combined with IT)	
Maximum OCT which can be accrued in IT and BT combined is 19 weeks	
Passed primary examination	
All BT WBAs	
All cases and procedures required for BT (including those to be completed in IT)	
ALS course completed during BT	
Scholar role requirements:	
Complete any two of the five required scholar role activities (for trainees who commenced on or after the start of the 2017 hospital employment year)	
Complete critical appraisal of a paper (for trainees who commenced before the start of the 2017 HEY and are completing scholar role option A).	
Core unit review	
A clinical placement review completed at the beginning and end of each placement and at least every 26 weeks.	

Advanced training core unit checklist	
Minimum of 104 weeks total training time recorded and confirmed, including:	
Minimum of 138 weeks CAT (combined with IT and BT)	
IT, BT and AT combined maximum 38 weeks OCT	
IT, BT and AT combined minimum of 11 weeks ICM (completed in BT or AT)	
Maximum of 16 weeks leave	
Passed final examination	
All AT WBAs (including WBAs required for the SSUs).	
All SSU reviews completed	
All cases and procedures required for AT (including those to be completed in IT, BT or AT and all cases required for the SSUs).	
EMST (required if VOP for trauma clinical fundamental is not met)	
ALS course completed during AT	
Scholar role requirements:	
All remaining scholar role activities (for trainees who commenced on or after the start of the 2017 hospital employment year).	
Teach a skill and facilitate a small group discussion (for trainees who commenced before the start of the 2017 HEY).	
Core unit review	
A clinical placement review completed at the beginning and end of each placement and at least every 26 weeks.	

Provisional fellowship training	
Minimum of 52 weeks total training time recorded and confirmed	
Minimum of 10 weeks spent in CAT or OCT	
Minimum of 4 weeks PFT time spent in clinical support activities	
Maximum of 8 weeks leave	
60 CPD points for every 52 weeks of PFT	
PFT WBAs: 2 CbDs and 1 MsF	
ALS course completed during PFT	
Provisional fellowship review	
Scholar role requirements:	
Attend two regional or greater conferences / meetings	
Participate in 20 existing quality assurance programs	
Complete an audit or approved option B activity (for trainees who commenced before the start of the 2017 HEY).	
Other:	
EMAC course completed and confirmed at any time after the completion of introductory training (IT)	
A clinical placement review completed at the beginning and end of each placement and at least every 26 weeks.	

Requirements of all training periods	
All required training fees paid	
Current medical registration – AHPRA/ MCNZ	
If training is interrupted for a continuous period of more than 52 calendar weeks subsequent training must include at least 52 weeks FTE continuous training time	
Has not exceeded the allowed training time at any training site	
Prospective approvals	
Scholar role activities are approved (when required)	
PFT approved (predefined/ individualised / overseas / part-time study plan)	
All part-time training approved	
All overseas training approved	
All training outside of anaesthesia, intensive care, pain medicine or allowed retrieval medicine approved
