

Over 1000 to attend Christchurch anaesthetists meeting

More than 1000 anaesthetists, pain medicine specialists and trainees from Australia, New Zealand and beyond will meet in Christchurch next month for the Annual Scientific Meeting of the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (ANZCA) and its Faculty of Pain Medicine (FPM).

Internationally renowned speakers from the US, Canada and the UK will be joined by Australian and New Zealand experts on the program titled “How meets why: Clinical practice and the science behind it”.

Each day, five sessions will be held concurrently alongside workshops and problem based learning discussions (PBLDs), a popular concept developed three years ago that allow discussion of real clinical cases amongst participants.
