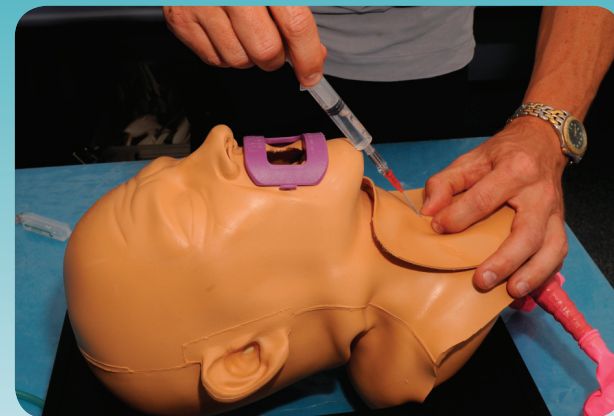

Workshop Overview

The RBWH Anaesthetic Department Airway faculty are offering a full day interactive airway workshop.

Highlights include:

- Group size limited to 8 per workshop
- A limit of 2 participants per manikin and wet lab station
- Focus on airway skills which may be difficult to acquire in the operating theatre
- Practice of needle and surgical cricothyroidotomy techniques
- Performing surgical airway techniques under the pressure of a 'can't intubate, can't ventilate' scenario
- Extensive hands on dexterity training with a fiberoptic scope
- Practice of Aintree catheter technique
- Accredited for 27 ANZCA CPD points under category 3/level 2.



Combined Fiberoptic & Surgical Airway Workshop

Workshop Program

- 0730 – 0800** introduction to surgical airways and discussion of recent coroner's cases
- 0800 – 0900** DRY LAB
2 participants per manikin
needle cricothyroidotomy
surgical cricothyroidotomy
conversion of needle cricothyroidotomy to cuffed airway
- 0900 – 1200** WET LAB
simulation of 'can't intubate, can't ventilate' scenario on anaesthetised sheep
- 1200 – 1230** LUNCH
- 1230 – 1300** Introduction to fiberoptic intubation
- 1300 – 1500** Hands-on fiberoptic training using Dexter manikins
includes practice of Aintree catheter technique on an anatomical manikin
- 1500 – 1530** Topicalisation of the airway and sedation for an awake fiberoptic intubation
- 1530 – 1630** Hands-on fiberoptic training using Dexter manikins
- 1630 – 1700** Practice assessment and discussion about difficult airway scenarios

Please note because of the wet lab component the times set out are a guide only and may change.

- August 26 – half day surgical airway workshop only for anaesthetists who have previously attended the fiberoptic workshop cost \$550

The wet lab component of the workshop is conducted at the Herston Medical Research Centre. All procedures performed have the full approval of the University of Queensland Animal Ethics Committee.
