


Document Delivery: Search the Discovery service and submit a request

The following procedure demonstrates how to quickly search the ANZCA Library discovery service for full-text access for articles and to submit an article request if no full-text article found. It assumes the user has an accurate article title.


1. Navigate to the *discovery service*: <https://anzca.on.worldcat.org/discovery>
2. Type/copy and paste in the *article title* into the search box and select the search **in Title** option to limit to a title-only search:




3. If **No results found**: select the: **Do you want to expand your search to libraries worldwide** link to expand your search (this enables you to search all articles listed in *PubMed*, etc not just those the library has full-text access to):

4. If **some results found**, but your **article isn't listed**: expand your search by selecting 'Libraries Worldwide' in the Library filter section of the left sidebar:



5. Optional: Further filter the results: **Format = Articles**








6. If your article is **listed** and **available full-text**: click on the [**View full text**] button
