The Epworth Richmond Intensive Care Unit is a 15 bed unit that admits and cares for more than 1700 patients per year. The case mix consists of major surgical patients (including cardiothoracic and neurosurgery) and a broad range of general medical patients.

Epworth Richmond is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) that offers high quality training. A teaching program designed for trainees in Intensive Care, Emergency Medicine and Anaesthetics is provided and the unit is approved for one year of advanced training by the CICM. It is also approved for all ICU component requirements for programmes of the ACEM, ANZCA and RACP.

The Registrar position suits a doctor with experience in intensive care, emergency medicine or anaesthesia, who possesses excellent communication skills and appropriate procedural skills for the care of the critically ill. The position will entail a total of 7 shifts per fortnight for Full time staff or 4 shifts per fortnight for Part time staff, and reimbursement is well above award rates, commensurate with the responsibility of the position and the experience of the candidate.

Applicants must be AMC Accredited and registered or eligible for registration by the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency. Applicants must also be a temporary or permanent Australian resident.
