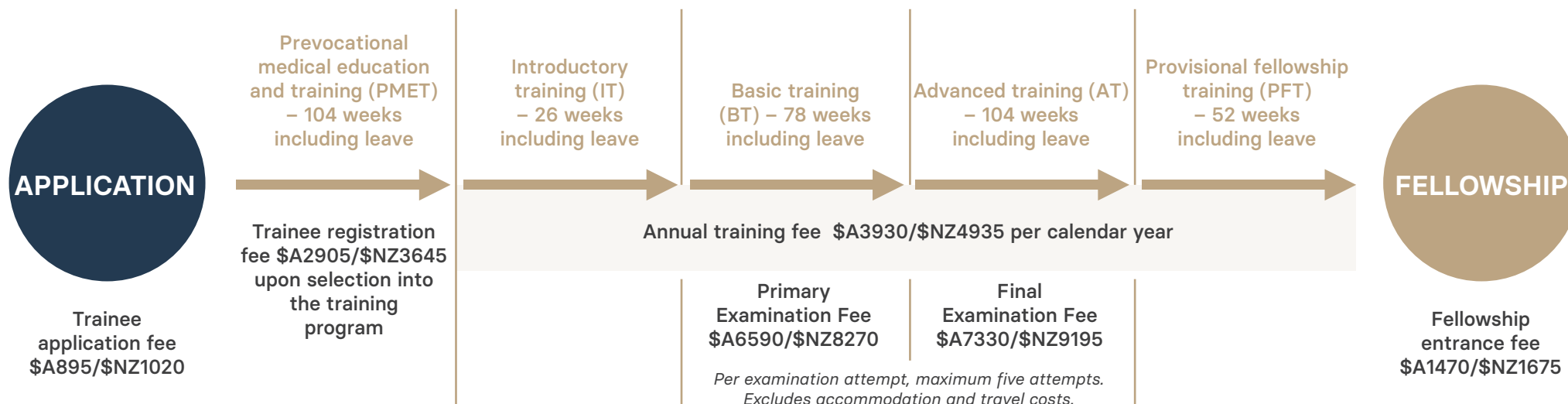


ANZCA training and assessment fees



Other fees that may apply to trainees include:

- Fees relating to mandatory courses as part of training (eg EMAC).
- Examination withdrawal fees (as applicable).
- Recognition of prior learning (RPL) fees (as applicable).
- Part-time application fee (adjustments).
- Registration maintenance fees (interrupted training).
- Review and appeal (RRA) fees.

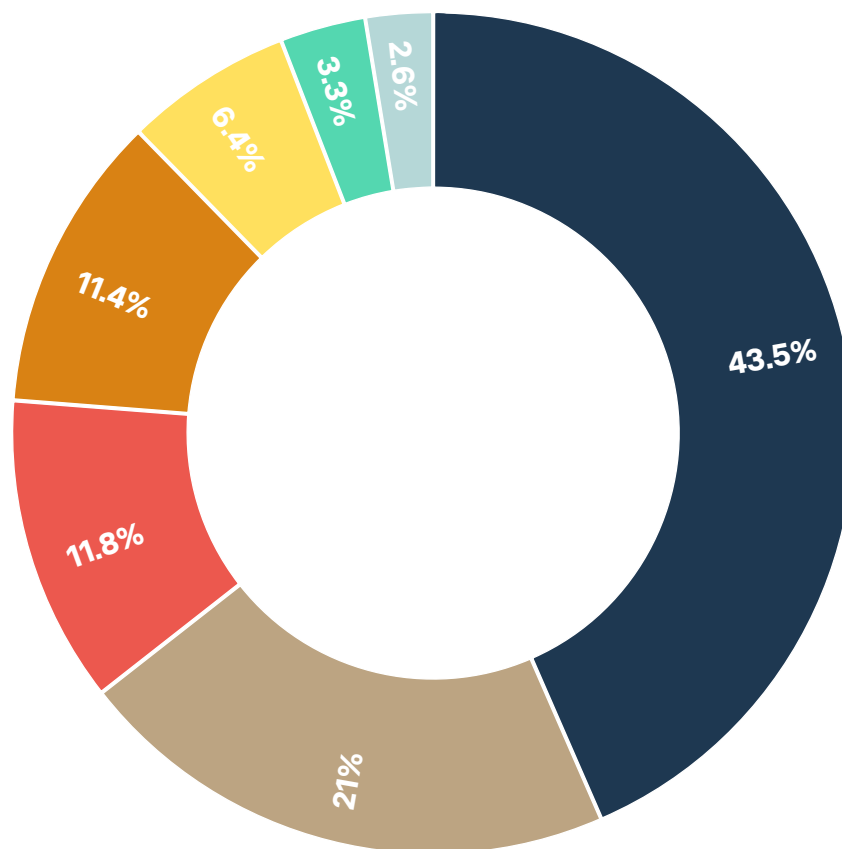

Where training and assessment fees go

Your annual training fee primarily funds the infrastructure required to run a world-class specialist training program. Examination fees are charged separately and contribute to the delivery of primary and final examinations.



● Anaesthesia Training Program

Includes education development initiatives for curriculum and assessment, Australian Medical Council compliance requirements, trainee support activities.

● Assessment delivery

Includes design, development and delivery of exams and other assessments, including venue and examiner costs.

● Governance and organisational support

Includes ANZCA Council/education committee support, communications, legal/risk, insurance, HR, finance.

● Training technology and digital platforms

Includes MyPortfolio, Training Site Accreditation platform, Exam Management System, etc.

● Accreditation of training settings

Includes accreditation of sites delivering the Anaesthesia Training Program.

● Clinical leadership and expertise

Includes directors of professional affairs and clinical leadership support for education development initiatives, trainee support, and assessor support.

● Learning resources and educational content

Includes development and curation of knowledge resources, including the ANZCA Library, for the anaesthesia training program.
