Special consideration application form

Regulation 44.13.3.9.2. Prospective RGA-SSSA candidates with a chronic illness or disability which may impact their performance will be considered for assistance appropriate to their disability, provided that this assistance does not compromise the fairness or reliability of the examination.

Candidates requesting special consideration based on their circumstances should submit this form along with supporting documentation. This must be sent at least 4 weeks prior to the exam application closing date. The special consideration application should include:

Candidates who are seeking special consideration based on their circumstances should submit this form along with supporting documentation. This submission must be made at least four weeks before the closing date for the exam application. The application for special consideration should include:

- 1. Evidence of the permanent and/or chronic impairment or disability (e.g. reports and recommendations from an educational psychologist for learning disabilities or medical reports on a medical condition.

 Any reports older than 18 months for learning disabilities will not be accepted.)
- 2. The evidence should indicate how your disability has affected/will affect your learning or performance at an exam.
- 3. The request to clearly state what award you are looking for.
- 4. Please note there will be no consideration for lowering of pass marks or additional time at the vivas.
