To be eligible to sit the external long case assessment, trainees need to meet the following eligibility criteria by the closing date. Trainees must have:

- Completed at least one satisfactory ITA.
- Completed the general physical examination assessment.
- Successfully completed a local long case at their training unit.
- Applied, nominated an examination venue and submit this form with payment of the application fee.

Trainees who have previously been unsuccessful at an external long case assessment need to repeat the local long case prior to the application closing date.

If the local long case was passed subsequent to the last ITA, please submit the long case documentation with this application.

Candidates with a chronic illness or disability who wish to apply for a special consideration must submit the fully documented application to the chair, Examination Committee at least four weeks prior to the relevant closing date.
