Role of airway leads

Airway leads may look towards some or all of the following to fulfill their position:

- Overseeing and assisting local airway training.
- Ensuring local policies for predictable airway emergencies exist and are available.
- Ensuring appropriate difficult airway equipment is readily available.

Liaising with the intensive care unit and emergency department. Actively engaging in airway device procurement. Ensuring consistency of airway assessment and planning. Overseeing audit of all aspects of airway management. Note that the role of the airway lead is not a formal requirement in the ANZCA accreditation process or part of the curriculum.
