  - **Manager** of him/herself; colleagues; staff of different categories and grades; facilities; equipment; finances
  - **Health Advocate**, including contributions to community organisations
  - **Scholar**, including commitment to continuing professional development; quality assurance; audit; teaching; research; publications/presentations
  - **Professional**, including contributions to hospital; university; regional/national/international organisations; and attributes such as honesty, integrity, cultural competence, justice, confidentiality and respect.
