25. ANZCA Council Citation

The ANZCA Council Citation was established by the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists in 2000.

- 25.1 This award is made at the discretion of ANZCA Council in recognition of significant contributions to particular activities of the College.
- 25.2 The award will also acknowledge the humanitarian endeavours of Fellows and trainees who make extraordinary and critically important contributions (clinical or non-clinical) in times of major disaster, conflict or in other circumstances outside the College. These Fellows or trainees will show particular selflessness, bravery and courage putting their own personal safety at risk to significantly impact the welfare, safety and survival of the community.

- 25.3 Nominations for the award will be considered at any ANZCA Council meeting.
- 25.4 All nominations will be made in writing, formally proposed by five Fellows and submitted to the chief executive officer at least 30 days before the ANZCA Council meeting.
- 25.5 Each nomination will be accompanied by the curriculum vitae of the nominee.
- 25.6 ANZCA Council will vote on the nomination by secret ballot.
- 25.7 No award will be made unless at least three-quarters of the voting members of the Council present and voting vote in favour, with abstentions not being counted in the total number of votes.
- 25.8 Nominations rejected by ANZCA Council may be reconsidered if formally proposed and seconded at a subsequent ANZCA Council meeting.
