

ANZCA Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Trainee Education Grant

The 2024 grant supports Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander doctors undertaking ANZCA or FPM training in Australia.

Note that Māori doctors training in Australia are also eligible to apply for this grant.

This annual grant awards funding of \$1,000 to recipients to use towards the payment of one or more of the following:

- College training fees
- College exam fees
- College exam preparation course

Trainees are eligible to apply for one education grant per calendar year.

The grant must be used within the calendar of which the grant is awarded.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- 1. Identify as an Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander and/or Māori doctor.
- 2. Reside in Australia.
- 3. Be registered as a trainee in the ANZCA or FPM training program.

To apply for this grant, please complete and submit the following form to <u>Indigenous Health</u> <u>Committee</u> by 30 November 2024.

Grants will be paid to trainees upon receipt from the trainee of a copy of a paid invoice for an eligible expense.

The total number of grants available each year is at the sole discretion of the Indigenous Health Committee.

In the event that more applications are received than grants available, priority will be given to those applicants undertaking a primary or final exam in the year of application.
