Role of airway leads

Airway leads may look towards some or all of the following to fulfill their position:

- Overseeing and assisting local airway training.
- Ensuring local policies for predictable airway emergencies exist and are available.
- Ensuring appropriate difficult airway equipment is readily available.
- Liaising with the intensive care unit and emergency department.
- Actively engaging in airway device procurement.
- Ensuring consistency of airway assessment and planning.
- Overseeing audit of all aspects of airway management.

Note that the role of the airway lead is not a formal requirement in the ANZCA accreditation process or part of the curriculum.
